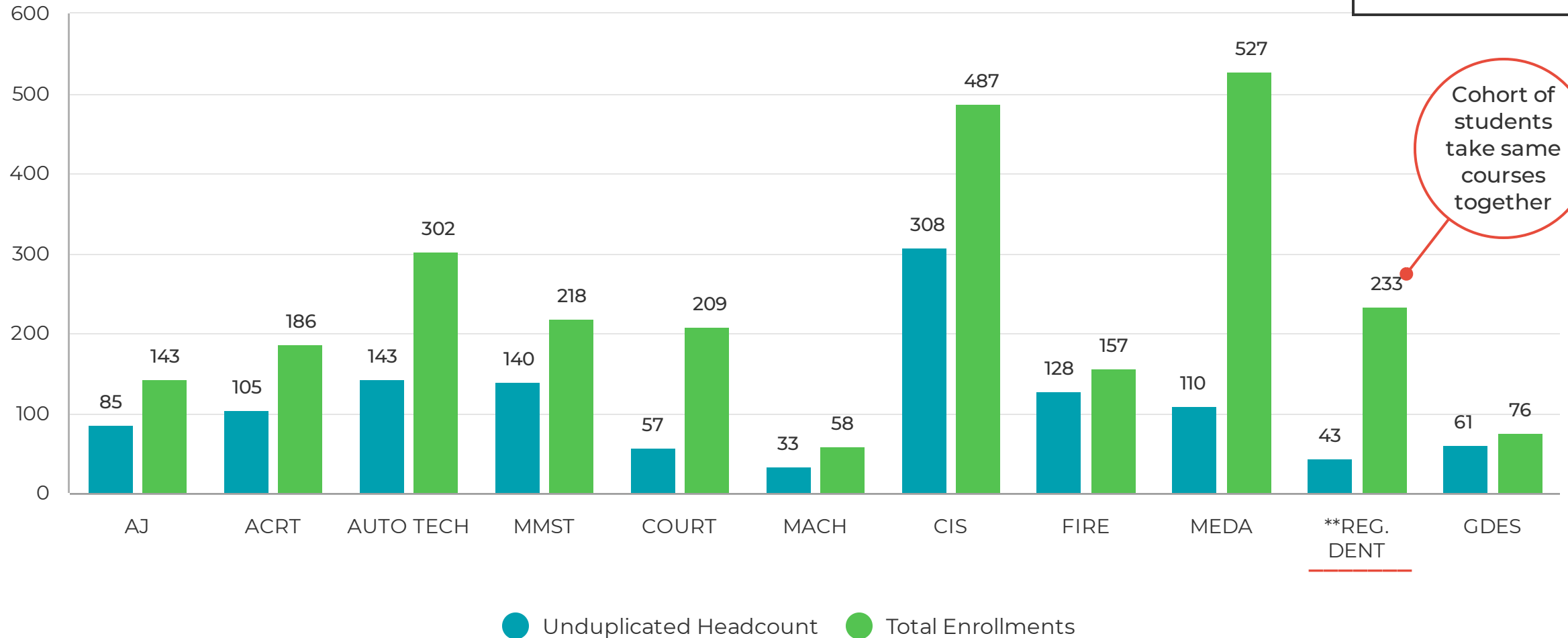

Growth for COM overall is up. Growth is mainly non-credit and ESL.

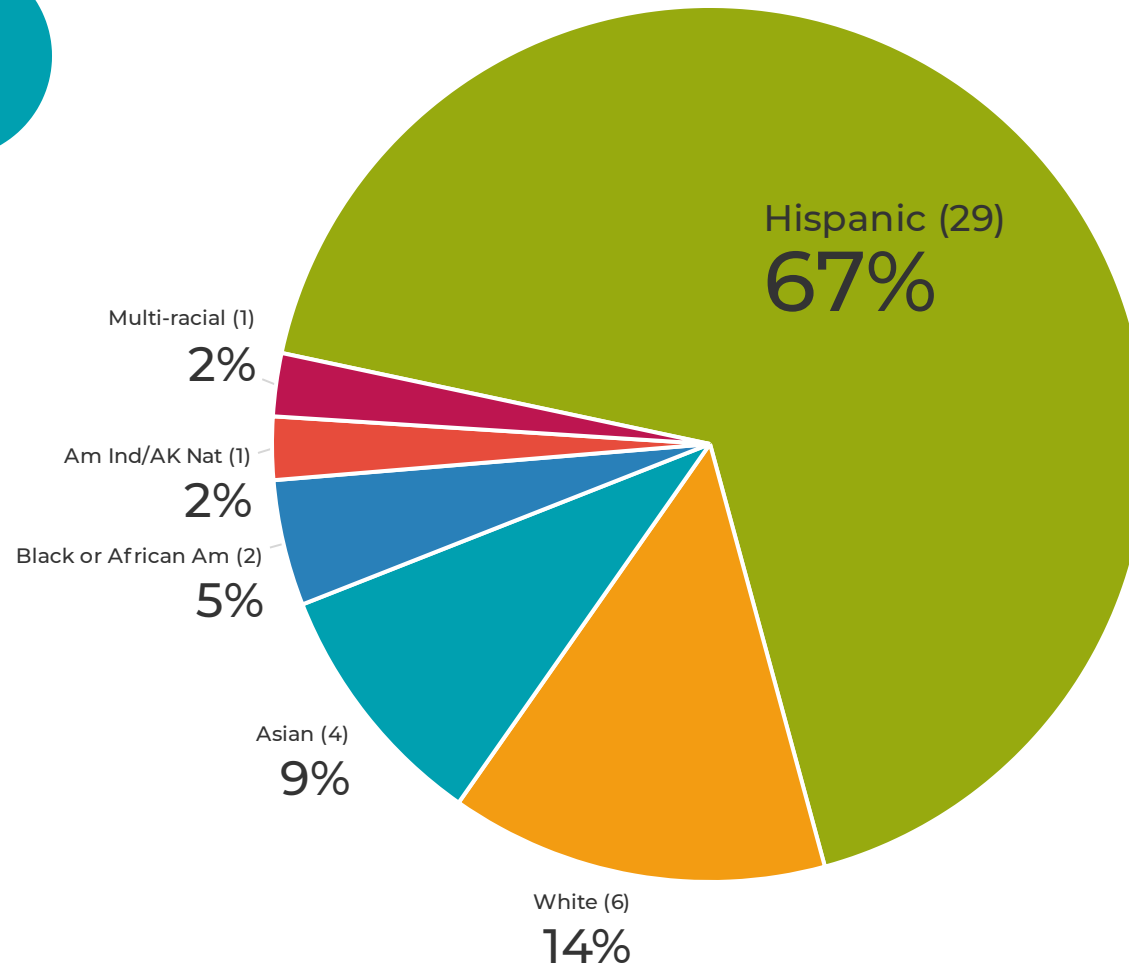

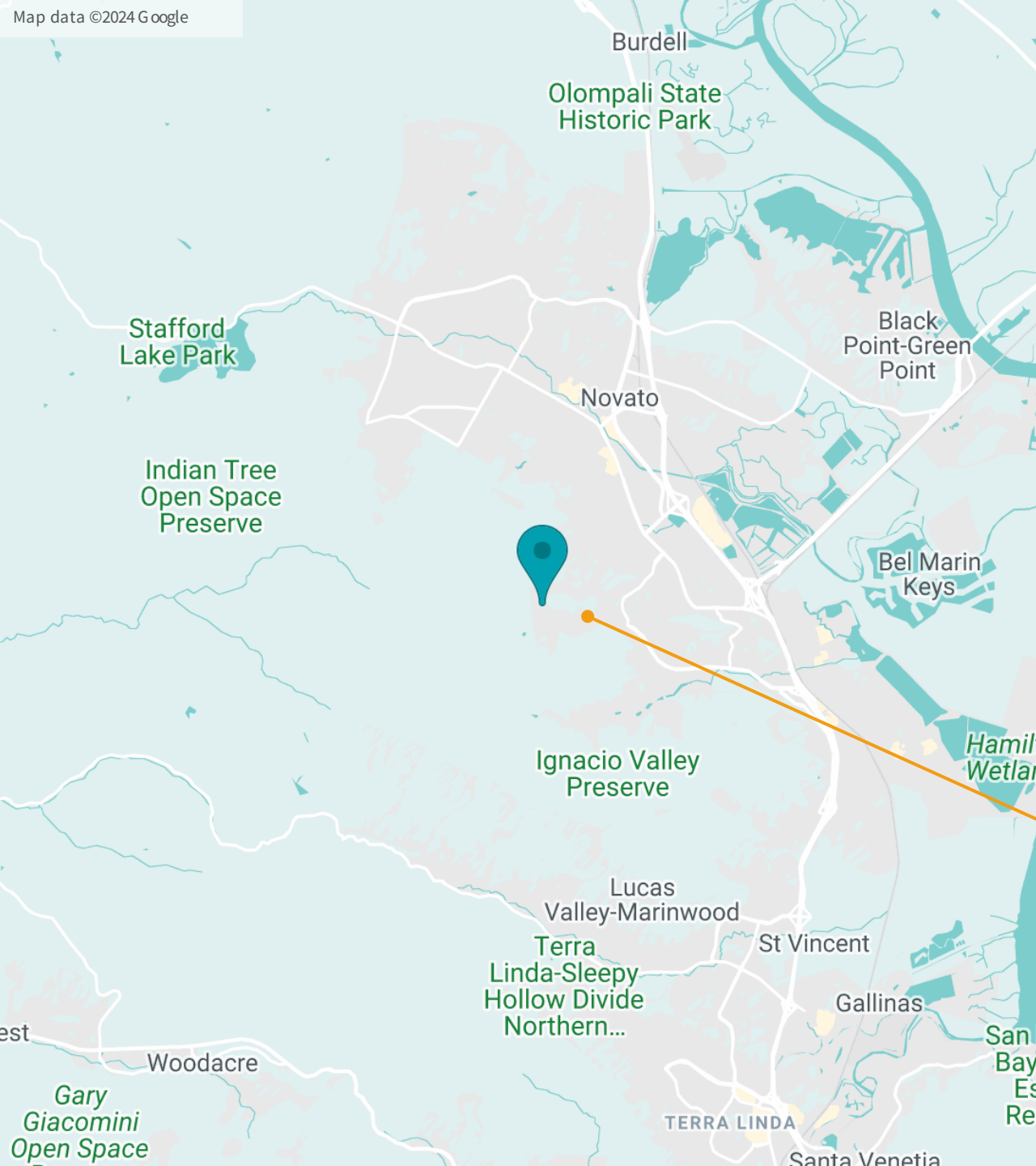
