- Industry growth of 13.4% expected by 2023
- Earnings avg \$73,672 in 2018
- 58 avg job openings/year



Graphic Design:

- Industry growth of 7.1% expected by 2023
- Earnings avg \$56,440 in 2018
- 134 avg job openings/year



Multimedia Artists and Animators:

- Industry growth of 2.4% expected by 2023
- Earnings avg \$79,395 in 2018
