Terrye from Touro University explained changes at Touro. They will have a new director as of June 13, 2022. Terrye will continue to be the Assistant Dean of Nursing. All schools are on the new campus in Vallejo. MSN, PA, NPH, Ed grad students. Touro is offering a program for students to transition to practice. 13 Fall units. Scholarships are available for 5-week course to degree program. Non-transfer credit for 5-week class. Monday evenings 4:30-7:30pm. Three hour virtual class for a total of 15 hour course. Also have a Capstone projects. 18 months from AND to MSN. Pipeline from AND to MSN to FNP.

Dr. Nicole Barnett from Kaiser Richmond is new to her role as CNO/CEO of Kaiser Richmond. Kaiser Richmond is a small; 8 bed ICU, OR, and an ED. She welcomes students but clinical cohorts should be no more than 8 students. Richmond would be good for Ped cohort; Outpatient clinics, Injection clinics, family medicine clinics. Also good for Med/Surg Fundamentals, ICU. Also new grad program within Kaisers. Over 100 spots on 21 campuses. There may be a summer residency cohort (4) in the ED. Two-four spots in the OR this summer. Watch for emails.

Dr. Barnett is also working with Alicia on CNA program to start in the Fall 2022.

Labor Market. Discussion on nurse residencies. Not many out in the world yet seems to be on the uptake.
